The IEEE International Symposium on Biomedical Imaging (ISBI) will host the first edition of a day-long special session designed to promote the exchange of emerging knowledge of biomedical imaging in the clinical fields. Clinical Day will contain sessions and plenary talks with specific emphasis in state-of-the-art translational and clinical imaging research. The focus area of clinical day will be on modern applications of neuroimaging to motor neuron disease, traumatic brain injury, and psychiatry.
